CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

The Meadowbank Division is located in the Nunavut territory at approximately 70 kilometers north of Baker Lake Community. Meadowbank has been in production since 2010 and employs approximately 500 people.

AIRPORT CONTROLLER

Under the supervision of the Services General Supervisor, the Airport Controller will be responsible for coordinating all the departures and arrivals of planes. The entitled person will produce reports on weather conditions and communicate them to pilots and all others concerned. He will be responsible for the use of navigational instruments designated by the competent authorities. In addition, he will coordinate possible evacuations and emergencies of all kinds.

The candidate must be qualified and possess a Certificate of VHF Radio. He must also have relevant experience of minimum 3 years in similar tasks. The candidate must also demonstrate an ability to make decisions quickly and be able to be creative. He should be able to work with minimal supervision and demonstrate respect and punctuality. Mastering English is essential.

MINING TECHNICIAN

Under the supervision of the Engineering Superintendent, the candidate will be mainly responsible to perform 3D modeling using software such as AutoCAD and Gemcom. He will also assist the mining engineers and will perform daily follow-up of the operations and production.

The ideal candidate possess a Degree or Diploma in mineral technology with experience of three (3) years as a mining technician. A good knowledge of Autocad, Gemcom and Microsoft Office Access is an asset.

HEAVY EQUIPMENT MECHANIC

Under the supervision of the Mechanical Supervisor, the entitled person will be responsible for preventive maintenance and any minor or major repairs on the mobile mining equipment and support equipment, in an environment of open pit mining.

The candidate we are looking for should have a minimum experience of three (3) years in mining related heavy equipment maintenance and must have an interprovincial Red Seal certification or the equivalent, with a thorough understanding of A/C, hydraulic and electrical system troubleshooting. The knowledge of the following is an asset: 777 and 785 Caterpillar Haul Trucks, 992 Caterpillar front end loaders, RH40 and RH120 front shovels, D8 and D9 Caterpillar track dozers, 16H, 160H and 16M Caterpillar graders, Dm45 and CM785 Atlas Copco drills. A valid driver's license is also required.

GENERAL SUPERVISOR SURFACE

Under supervision of Superintendent General Services, the holder of the post is directly responsible for a team of supervisors to the surface and is hierarchically responsible for teams of engineers of buildings, electricians, plumbers, carpenters, and operators to the surface. It is responsible for planning and scheduling of work with predictive equipment industry, corrective and preventive maintenance. It shall also ensure maintenance of the runway, the local materials transport and unloading of barges. The candidate will have to work closely with operations staff to maintain and increase the availability of production equipment. It will also work closely with other supervisors and planners in the maintenance department.

Holder holds a Degree College study in maintenance of fixed machinery or electricity or even has a relevant equivalence coupled with 5 years experience in supervisory personnel. He is familiar with modern techniques. He has had to work with the codes and regulations governing related work to those mentioned above. He knows the technical maintenance of fire protection networks water drinking and worn, electrical distribution and is able to interpret the plans and specifications. He has knowledge from lifting, heating, air conditioning and central maintenance management system equipment. Finally, the candidate demonstrates many leadership and relevant experience in similar functions of supervision and coordination.

PRODUCTION EQUIPMENT OPERATORS

Under the supervision of the Mine Supervisor, the entitled person will comply with the digging plan and verifies rock variety before loading the trucks. The candidates we are looking for are for the following equipment: RH 40, RH 120 Front Shovels and 992 Loaders.

The candidates we are looking for should have a minimum experience of three (3) years in heavy equipment operation as mentioned.

MAINTENANCE PLANNER

Under the supervision of the Senior Planner, the entitled person will be responsible for providing service and support for the process plant or the mine department. In order to do so, one of the maintenance planners main responsibilities will be to develop and maintain an overall maintenance program that includes preventive maintenance, equipment availability as well as parts and supplies. The entitled person will also have to participate in the planning of upcoming projects, scheduling and budgeting.

The candidate we are looking for should have a maintenance management diploma or equivalent, as well as a minimum of four (4) years in the mining industry or in a related industry. Maintenance planning or trade experience is also required.

METALLURGIST TECHNICIAN

Under the supervision of the Senior Metallurgist, the candidate will perform various work in order to improve ore processing at the process plant and in the laboratory. The candidate will monitor reagents (inventory control) and the preparation of daily balances. The candidate will participate in planning and implementing campaigns to include sampling, sample preparation, while also drafting reports for the various metallurgical work for which he has responsibility. The candidate must be able to develop procedures and to track the use of those procedures. The person will also keep track of instruments in use at the process plant to ensure their reliability.

The candidate must possess a Degree or Diploma in mineral technology (mineral processing option). The person should demonstrate autonomy, organization and openness to work as a team member. The candidate must be able to communicate effectively and be able to integrate into a team already in place. Computer skills are essential using Office Suite and ability to use Access is an asset.

MINE TRAINER

Under the supervision of the Training Coordinator, the entitled person will be responsible to dispense training to employees in the mine department for heavy equipment. In order to do so, the Mine Trainer will participate in the identification of training needs related to the task of the employees. Preparation and adaptation of various training content related to changes of procedures or to new equipment acquisition. Updating the employees training records is also part of the Mine Trainer responsibilities.

The candidate we are looking for should have a minimum experience of ten (10) years as Heavy Equipment Operator in open pit and a strong experience as a trainer and a well-developed expertise regarding heavy equipment.

SENIOR METALLURGIST

Under the supervision of the Chief Metallurgist, the entitled person will be responsible for providing technical support to existing operations either in the development of new processes, optimizing projects or problem solving within the systems in place. As part of the work which he is responsible, he will take charge of planning and monitoring resources and deadlines. The candidate must also work jointly with other departments in order to achieve common goals.

The candidate we are looking for owns a Bachelor degree Metallurgical Engineer with a minimum of 5 years experience preferably in gold process plant. Familiarity with Sag mill operations and gravity systems knowledge of intense cyanide leaching with CIP understanding.

HOUSEKEEPING LEADER

Under the supervision of the Front Desk Officer, the Housekeeping Leader will have the responsibility to plan, organize, direct and control activities of his sector.
