



EOL CARE NETWORK LEAD LOCATION – THUNDER BAY

The Northwestern Ontario End-of-Life (EOL) Care Network is recruiting for a key position which will provide strategic leadership and guidance to the Network and its organizational partners. This is a full time contract position for two to three years, with the possibility of extension.

The Northwest EOL Care Network is one of 14 EOL Care Networks across the province that are working together to improve access, quality and integration of palliative care services. The Northwest EOL Care Network Lead will take direction from the Steering Committee of the NW End of Life Care Network. The incumbent will be employed by St. Joseph's Care Group and be accountable to the NWO Network Chair.

The incumbent will have strong collaborative skills in order to work effectively with provincial networks/agencies and other community groups to initiate integrated palliative care program design while fulfilling the Network's mandate and vision. The role is well-suited to creative, progressive thinkers with an aptitude for building relationships and identifying opportunities. Regional travel is required.

The ideal candidate will have a Master's degree in a health-related discipline, health administration or relevant field from a recognized University or equivalent qualifications obtained through education and experience. This position will appeal to an individual who has demonstrated interest and experience in community development, palliative care and rural health.

The EOL Network partner organizations, which include the North West Community Care Access Centre, St. Joseph's Care Group and Thunder Bay Regional Health Sciences Centre, are willing to consider a temporary secondment to this position for the successful candidate, contingent on mutual agreement among all parties.
