Reporting to the Principal, the designated early childhood educator will partner with the classroom teacher to plan and implement a full day early learning program supporting faith initiatives in a Catholic classroom setting. The ideal candidates will possess a two year Early Childhood Education Diploma and be registered with the College of Early Childhood Educators, have a minimum of 3 to 5 years experience in a childcare or educational setting, knowledge of Ministry of Education's full day early learning program and related legislation, proven ability to work as a member of a team, proven ability to communicate in a sensitive and courteous manner with children, parents, staff and the general public, proven commitment to maintaining confidentiality, proven ability to deal with classroom management, stressful and emergency situations, experience in the planning and implementation of age appropriate Catholic programs, basic computer skills, strong organization and time management skills and have the ability to meet deadlines.

The successful applicants will be required to provide a Tuberculin Skin Test and a Vulnerable Sector Screening document deemed satisfactory to the Board.
